## Meal Time

## Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What is something good that has happened lately to you or a friend?"



## Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, we thank You for the good things You have given us. May we notice examples of your kindness and generosity every day."

Pray for each other: "God, when we see someone in need, help us to know how to help them with what we have."

## Morning Time

## Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "How does it make you feel when you give to others?"



## Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Who is someone you think has a good attitude about things? Why do you think that?"



## Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, may we always give with a good attitude. You have given us so much, and we thank You for the chance to give back some of what You have given us to be a part of the good things You are doing."
