Burning Bush

Exodus 3:1-18, 6:11; Psalm 118:7

God speaks to Moses from a burning bush and tells Moses to lead God's people out of Egypt.



Talk About the Bible Story

Open the Bible together and read Exodus 3:1-18, 6:11; Psalm 118:7 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's a new day to trust in the Lord with all our heart!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, help [child's name] and me trust You and do what You say like Moses did. We know You love us and will always know what is best for us."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for bushes. What color are they? Are they big or small? Talk about how God used a burning bush to get Moses' attention so Moses would listen to God.



Bath Time

Add orange bath foam/soap to bath time. Tell your child to separate the bubbles into balls and let them float on top of the water. Talk about how the bubbles look like little burning bushes, like the one God used to talk to Moses. Moses trusted that God's got it...and He did!

Open the Bible together and read Exodus 13:3-4, 21-22 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

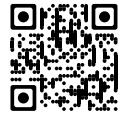
Engagement Questions

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! I don't know everything that's going to happen today, but I do know that God's got it!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, we want to go Your way because Your way is always best. Thank You for sending Jesus to show us the way to love one another."



Drive Time

While on the go, look up at the clouds during the day and the moon and stars at night. Talk about how God used a tall cloud during the day and a tall fire during the night to show God's people the way to go.



Bath Time

During bath time, sing the following words to the tune of "Three Blind Mice": "Trust in the Lord. (*Repeat three times.*) Trust in the Lord with all your heart. (*Repeat twice.*) Trust in the Lord."

Elijah and the Widow

1 Kings 17:1-16

Elijah and a woman trust God, and God makes the oil and flour not run out.



Talk About the Bible Story

Open the Bible together and read 1 Kings 17:1-16 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

- Who's got it?
- What food do you like to eat?

Weekly Parent Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Do you know why today is a GREAT day? God loves you, and God loves me!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, sometimes things happen that make us feel sad or mad, worried or afraid. Thank You that we can trust You no matter what. Happy or sad, You love us, and You've got it!"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask: "If you could have one food never run out, what would it be?" Talk about how God made the oil and flour not run out for Elijah, the woman, and her son so they could make bread to eat.



Bath Time

Add toy food items and toy dishes to bath time. Ask your child to pretend they are a chef and cook food. While you play together, talk about how Elijah and the woman trusted God for their food and how God made their food not run out!

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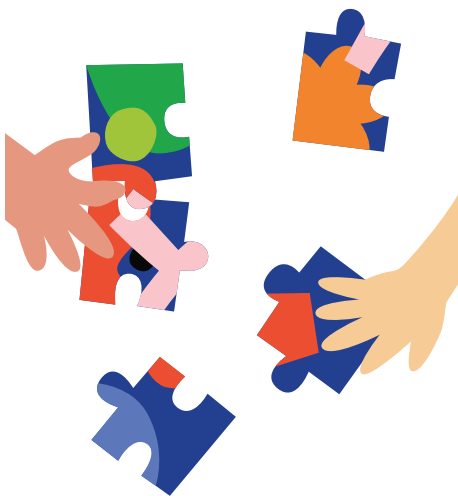

Weekly Parent Cues



Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Let's start the day talking to God. We can tell God anything, because we can talk to God about anything!" (*Pray together.*)



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, I'm so glad [child's name] and I can talk to You about anything. You love us, and You just want us to talk to You. Today, we want to talk to You about...(*ask your child what they want to talk to God about.*) We love You, God!"



Drive Time

While on the go, talk about how we can talk to God about anything. Then, take turns thanking God for things you see.



Bath Time

Gather a few small items, like a toy animal, flower, and person. During bath time, line the items along the tub and cover them with a cup. Each time your child lifts a cup, say: "We can talk to God about [name of item]." End saying: "We can talk to God about anything!"
